To take this course at RSC, the student must confirm that it will fit into the associate's degree without exceeding the requirements. A minimum of 60 hours must be taken at a baccalaureate granting institution. Exceeding 64 credit hours at the community college means the student will be required to take more than the minimum of 124 credit hour total. A minimum of 40 hours of 3/4000 level courses are required for the baccalaureate. Courses at community colleges are 1/2000 level.

 - (3) the requirements for teacher certification.

- A student must earn at least 60 semester hrs., excluding physical activity courses, at a baccalaureate degree granting institution.
- A Student must earn at least 124 credit hrs. that apply to an ECU Bachelor's degree.
