- If you are a first time loan borrower at RSC, you must complete Loan Entrance Counseling and a Master Promissory Note (MPN) at StudentAid.gov

Per federal regulations, if you are a first time college student, you must attend classes for 30 days before you are eligible for your first loan disbursement.



REFUNDS AND TEXTBOOK PURCHASING

Activate your BankMobile account to receive financial aid refunds.

Your Refund Selection Kit will arrive in a bright green envelope and will contain your Personal Code.

Visit RefundSelection.com to select how you'd like to receive your money.

Pell Grant recipients may have the option to charge their books to their bursar account.

FINANCIAL AID VOCABULARY & RESOURCES

Grants - Financial aid that doesn't have to be repaid (unless, for example, you withdraw from school and owe a refund)

Loans - Borrowed money for college that you must repay, with interest, to the U.S. Department of Education

Work Study - a work program through which you earn money to help you pay for school

Student Aid Index (SAI) - Your SAI is determined by the financial information - including income and assets - you provide on your FAFSA. The college will use your SAI to help determine your eligibility for financial aid. For more information, visit StudentAid.gov.

Satisfactory Academic Progress - standards to ensure that you are completing your coursework and can continue to receive financial aid. For more information, visit www.rose.edu/content/admissions-aid/financial-aid-scholarships/
