

Articulation & Reverse Transfer Agreement Rose State College & Mid-America Christian University

This formal articulation agreement is made and entered into by Rose State College, hereinafter referred to as Rose State, and Mid-America Christian University, hereinafter referred to as MACU. By this agreement, Rose State and MACU (hereinafter collectively "The Institutions") express a shared commitment to increase opportunities for student access to, and success in, higher education. By clarifying transfer policies and procedures that assure articulation between programs, the Institutions seek to forge a seamless transfer from the associate to the baccalaureate degree, and the baccalaureate to the master's degree.

General Provisions

1. The Institutions will develop agreements by major which will clearly delineate courses to be taken at Rose State and those to be completed at MACU. These specified, individualized plans will be between the two institutions in service of the students who choose to participate in these plans. These plans will outline recommended courses toward a degree at MACU for Rose State students.
2. MACU and Rose State college faculty of the same disciplines will meet to develop course/degree articulations, and meet annually thereafter. These meetings will be directed by the appropriate college administrators, and will focus on discussing course equivalencies, as well as any contemplated curricular changes that may affect the future of this agreement.
3. The Institutions will identify problems and work cooperatively to adjust details of course content and sequence so that students can transfer with minimal academic disruption.
4. MACU agrees that criteria for acceptance into a baccalaureate degree program will be the same for Rose State transfer students as for students who begin their studies at MACU.
 - Rose State students who complete the Associate in Arts (AA), Associate in Science (AS) or Associate in Applied Science degree (AAS) with a minimum 2.0/4.0 GPA will be eligible to apply for admission to MACU baccalaureate programs with the exception of the Teacher Education program. Rose State students wishing to transfer to a MACU Teacher Education program must complete a minimum 2.5/4.0 CGPA. Rose State students desiring to transfer PRIOR TO the completion of the associate degree must have completed all developmental coursework, and have a minimum 2.0/4.0 cumulative CGPA.

Advising, Enrollment & Recruiting/Marketing Provisions

5. A notation of the articulation partnership and specific agreements between Rose State and MACU will be indicated in the respective catalogs and institution websites.

Terms

Upon execution of this agreement, the arrangement shall continue until terminated by either party with one year written notice.

Notice of termination by either party to the other shall be in writing and addressed to the party to be notified with return receipt requested, or by personal delivery to the person to be notified.
