Satisfactory Academic Progress

While receiving Federal Aid, Oklahoma's Promise, or Ticket to Rose, students must meet certain minimum standards. These standards are referred to as **Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress** (SAP). It is the student's responsibility to know and understand these requirements. In short a student must complete their degree within a specified number of hours, meet both a minimum cumulative GPA requirement AND meet the minimum pace (completion percentage) requirement to remain eligible for aid. Students who do not meet these requirements as defined in the policy will lose their eligibility for aid until such time as they are meeting the requirements. Use the Pace Calculator below to determine your academic progress.

- Step 1: Log into OASIS and go to your unofficial transcript.
- Step 2: Find your transcript totals.
- Step 3: Enter your attempted hours and transfer earned hours. Attempted hours include grades of "W" which are not included in the total hours on the RSC transcript. You will need to add those hours to your totals.

If your current pace is **less than 67%**, you need to improve your ratio of earned credits to attempted credits. Remember that <u>your pace will be reviewed at the end of each semester</u>. If your aid is suspended, you are not eligible until you successfully appeal to have your aid reinstated or you are meeting <u>both</u> the GPA and Pace requirements.

In order to calculate your future pace, you should add hours to both Step 3 Attempted Hours and Step 4 Earned Hours.
