Up to one year of continuing care is also provided.
- Other drug and alcohol treatment services available at the drug rehab center's office include traditional outpatient, telehealth, individual and group counseling, relapse prevention, assessments/evaluation services and continuing care.
- Office hours are from 1 p.m. to 10 p.m. Monday through Friday and outpatient services are Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 6-9 p.m.
