Special Care offers year-round early childhood education, therapy, and after school and summer programs for children with and without special needs. Programs include year-round direct care, early childhood education, and before/after school programs, as well as on-site therapy services. In addition, Special Care's Autism Clinic provides one-on-one therapy for children in our program with autism spectrum disorders.

- Children ages 6 weeks to 6 years participate in classes according to developmental level.
- Each class is designed to meet the educational, therapeutic, and emotional needs of each child, and approximately 90 of the 135 children education classrooms.
- Each child has an individual education plan and participates in activities designed for social-emotional, physical, language, and cognitive development.
- Teachers, therapists, and parents work together to design short and long-term goals for each child.

- Teachers and therapists also work closely for optimal carryover between therapy and classroom activities.
