#### Ms. Toney Dake - Member-at-Large ---

As a sophomore at Central State College (now the University of Central Oklahoma), I was offered a position on staff as a Respiratory Therapist at a local hospital. I was so drawn to the profession that I changed my major to Respiratory Therapy and graduated from Oklahoma University Health Sciences Center. I then received an undergraduate and graduate degree from UCO.

In 1980, while holding a position of Educational Coordinator at Baptist Medical Center, I was contacted by Dan Points, Dean of Health Sciences, to apply for the position of Director of Clinical Education of the Respiratory Therapy Program. That fall I signed my first contract and for the next 28 years, shared my expertise and knowledge with so many students who would become some of the most prominent Registered Respiratory Therapists in our profession.
