-- To continue with our spotlighting officers on being hired at Rose State, we are spotlighting:

#### Claudia Buckmaster

In the late 1980's, I was English Chair and teaching AP classes at Union High School and at the downtown campus of Tulsa Community College, but knew I would eventually need to move back to the Oklahoma City area to be close to my mother. Since I loved living in Tulsa and had a terrific job at Union, I wanted to delay the permanent move, but sent applications to several central Oklahoma colleges for a summer adjunct position so I could spend some time here. Among the responses I received was a call from Treva George, the Associate Dean of Humanities, to tell me that although she had no vacant adjunct position for the summer, they were looking for two full-time English faculty, and she hoped I would apply. Believing every opportunity should be explored, at the very least, I went through the application and interview process. I was ambivalent about the whole thing and pretty relaxed in my approach, so I was a little shocked when Dean Cooksey called to offer me the job. It was a painful dilemma; I didn't want to leave Tulsa, but after some agonizing thought realized it was an opportunity I better not turn down because it might not be there next year or the year after when I thought I was ready. That is how I came to Rose State College in Fall 1990 as an English professor. They haven't been able to get rid of me since.

#### Dr. Sid Carter

I was a teacher in the Oklahoma City Public School System when I heard that Oscar Rose Junior College was looking for a Student Activities Director. My wife, who was already employed at Oscar Rose in the Office of Veterans Affairs (Curt Robertson was her boss), encouraged me to apply for the position. I applied and was interviewed by Dr. Charles Brown who hired me on the spot for the position in 1972.
