<u>Important Note:</u> The instructions below apply to the student and spouse (if the student is married). Notify the financial aid office if the student or spouse filed separate IRS income tax returns for 2023 or had a change in marital status after December 31, 2023.

<u>Instructions:</u> Complete this section if the student and spouse <u>filed or will file</u> a 2023 IRS income tax return(s). As part of federal student aid eligibility, students, and spouses (as appropriate), will be required to consent and approve sharing and importing income and tax information from the IRS to the FAFSA form, even if the attempt to obtain or use such data is ineffective. A 2023 IRS Tax Return Transcript may be obtained through:

<u>Get Transcript by Mail</u> – Go to <u>www.irs.gov</u>, click "Get Your Tax Record." Click "Get Transcript by Mail." Make sure to request the "Return Transcript" and NOT the "Account Transcript." The transcript is generally received within 10 business days from the IRS's receipt of the online request.

<u>Get Transcript Online</u> – Go to <u>www.irs.gov</u>, click "Get Your Tax Record." Click "Get Transcript Online." Make sure to request the "Return Transcript" and NOT the "Account Transcript." Follow the instructions to create an <u>ID.me</u> account if you do not already have one. If you need help creating an <u>ID.me</u> account or verifying your identity, visit the <u>ID.me</u> IRS Help Site.

<u>Automated Telephone Request</u> – 1-800-908-9946. Transcript is generally received within 10 business days from the IRS's receipt of the telephone request.

<u>Paper Request Form – IRS Form 4506T-EZ or IRS Form 4506-T</u>. The transcript is generally received within 10 business days from the IRS's receipt of the paper request form.
